

### Call for abstracts

We are pleased to formally invite you to participate and submit abstract to the IV International Congress on Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (ICNN-2019). This congress will take place in Quito (Ecuador) between the **19**<sup>th</sup> **November to 22**<sup>nd</sup> **November 2019**. The goal of ICNN-2019 is to provide a global platform for researchers coming from academia and industry to present their results and activities in the field of fundamental and interdisciplinary research of Nanoscience and Nanotechnology.

One participant can submit up to one abstract as the presenting author. There is no restriction of abstracts of which one participant can be co-author.

The deadline of abstracts submission and registration is the **15**th **August 2019**.

- Submit abstract in MS Word format through the website (platform)

- Nanofabrication, Synthesis, Characterization and Engineering
- Nanoelectronics and microsystems
- Nanotechnology in Energy and Environment

#### Important dates:

- Deadline for abstract submission: 15th August 2019
- Confirmation of oral or poster presentation: 15th October 2019









- Deadline for extended abstract submission: 25th October 2019
- Congress: 19th November to 22nd November 2019.

#### **Presentation type**

The ICNN-2019 will consist of oral presentations and poster sessions selected from a scientific committee. The acceptance notice for oral or poster presentation will be notified to the corresponding author by **15**<sup>th</sup> **October 2019**. Poster dimensions should correspond to portrait DIN A0 format. Dimensions are 1189 X 841 mm or 46.8 X 33.1 in.

The deadline for the extended abstract "Maximum 4 pages with graphs/tables/references" submission is **25**<sup>th</sup> **October 2019**.

The authors can publish their works as a full article in a special issue of an indexed journal after peer-review process "Journal of Advanced Research". Follow the author's instructions of journal carefully during the preparation of your manuscripts. Please submit manuscript by using online submission system. Registration fees. #### **Abstract Format and Submission**

Abstract should be prepared in a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx) in British English and not exceed **250** words (times new roman, font 12). Abstracts exceeding 250 words will be truncated.

Abstract will be reviewed by the scientific committee based on originality / novelty, significance of research findings / ideas and relevance to the main theme. Abstract should consist of a title (Times New Roman, font 12, not be capitalized, only first letter in capital) and not exceeding 20 words.

Author and co-authors' details (all in lower case):

- Full first and family name(s) (Times New Roman, font 12)
- Presenting author's name should be in **bold**.
- Affiliation details: department, institution, city, state (Times New Roman, font 10, in italics)
- E-mail address of corresponding author (Times New Roman, font 10, in italics)

Abstract layout (Times New Roman, font 12) - Abstracts must contain the following:

- Background/problem statement
- Objective(s)
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

The tables, References and figures cannot be included. Latin names should be written with *italic font*.

All abstracts should be submitted and presented in appropriate English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication prior to submission. The abstract cannot be retyped or corrected once it is submitted to the Scientific Committee. In case of correction, get in contact with the Scientific Secretariat. It is the author's responsibility to submit the abstract in perfect order with no errors in spelling or grammar.

Please type in your abstract text (times new roman, font 12) here in one single paragraph. Abstract should contain the following: Background/problem statement, Objective(s), Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
